## **FEEDING DIRECTIONS**

Seminole Senior Formula is a premium quality, complete feed scientifically designed for aged horses. Start the feeding program using the feeding directions for the weight and activity level of the horse. After observing and/or weighing the horse for a period of time, increase or decrease the daily feeding rate to obtain the desired body condition or body weight.

Seminole Senior Formula can be fed as the sole ration, at a rate up to 2% of the horse's body weight per day. Feed hay and/or equivalent pasture at the rate of 1 to 2 pounds per 100 pounds of body weight daily. If your aged horse is unable or has a dental condition which would prevent the chewing or swallowing of hay, pasture or other long-stemmed forage, it is recommended that an alternative form of long-stem fiber be provided, such as hay cubes or chopped hays, which can be soaked and safely fed. This feed can also be offered as a mash with the addition of water. When the amount of Seminole Senior Formula exceeds 1.5% of the horse's body weight, it should be divided into 3 or more feedings per day.

Do not feed Seminole Senior Formula on a free choice basis. Feed at regular times, with two or more equal feedings per day. Make all feed changes gradually, over a 7-10 day period. Increases in feeding rate should not exceed 1 pound per day for an individual horse. Delay feeding a horse that has been exercised or is exhibiting pain, fever or diarrhea. Seminole Senior Formula weighs approximately 1.6 pounds per dry US quart. Provide a free choice horse mineral such as Seminole Grass Balancer 16:8 Mineral or Alfa Balancer 12:12 Mineral on a continuous basis. Provide clean, fresh water at all times.
